The <u>2-year, graduate program</u> prepares students to work collaboratively as healthcare providers who are an integral part of the sports medicine team. Our program focuses on creating patient-centered and evidence-informed healthcare providers who can serve as advocates for their patients both on and off the field to improve health-related quality of life.

- The University of Arkansas has a rich history in master's-level athletic training education and has been accredited since 2005.
- Clinical placements are possible in diverse settings including universities, secondary schools, physician and therapy clinics, professional sports, and emerging settings.
- The program has an average, first-time pass rate on the Board of Certification exam above 97% over the past 9 years.
